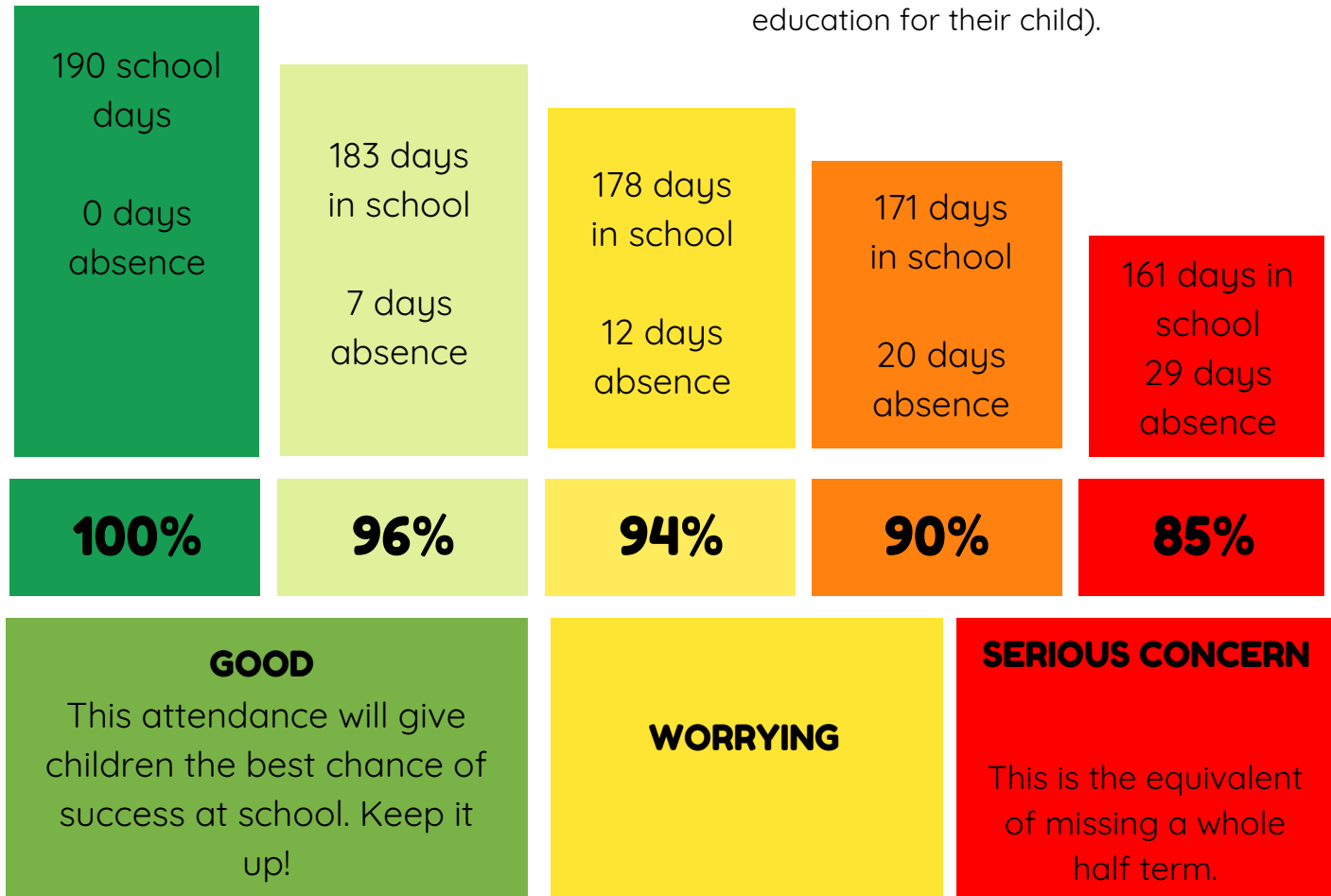
There are 175 non-schol days during the year to spend on family time, visits, holidays, shopping, household jobs and appointments.
