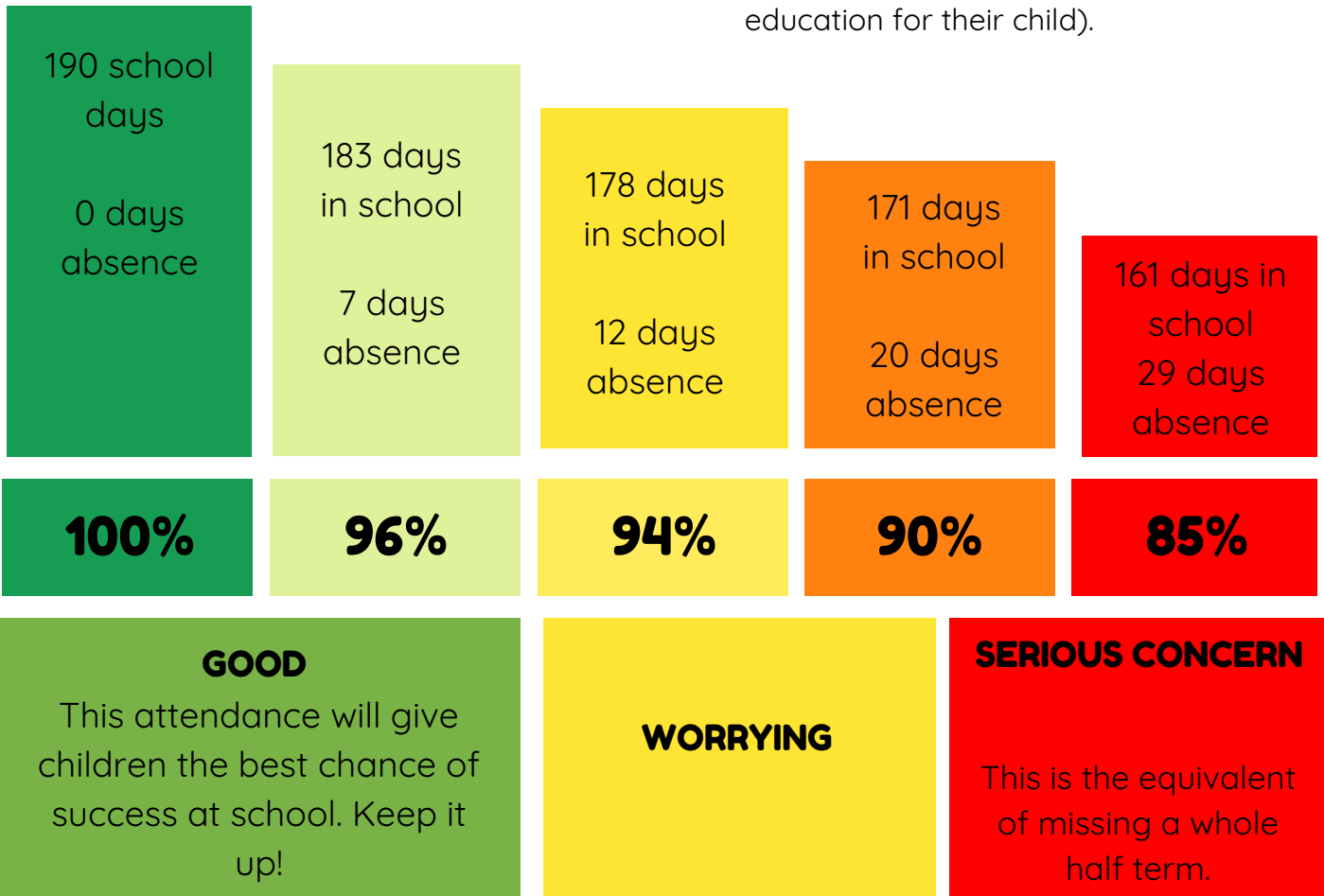
There are 175 non-schol days during the year to spend on family time, visits, holidays, shopping, household jobs and appointments.

Under section 7 of the Education Act 1996, the parent/carer is responsible for ensuring that their child of compulsory school age receives efficient full-time education that is suitable to their child's age, ability and aptitude and to any special educational needs the child may have.
